Genotype C to be electronically tagged

Government scientists have discovered a strong link between carriers of genotype C and higher levels of criminality. As a result, the government is currently drafting a white paper to introduce legislation, forcing genotype C carriers to wear electronic tags.

Gillian Bevan, a spokesperson for the Department of British Homelands Security said today 'these measures will ensure the people of Britain can feel safer on the streets and in their homes.'
